The **Trauma Assessment, Resuscitation and Transport (TART)** program is an education initiative of the NSW Institute of Trauma and Injury Management (ITIM) in collaboration with the Sydney Clinical Skills and Simulation Centre (SCSSC) and CareFlight.

The TART program is delivered in regional areas across NSW, free of charge. The two and a half day education program consists of three separate and exciting components, combining a trauma seminar in the evening, a day of practicing your trauma skills, followed by trauma team training on day 2.

Program:

Day 1: Monday 14th November

Trauma Evening: 1630 - 2030hrs (open to all, limited places*)

The trauma evening seminar will consist of presentations and discussions delivered by experienced trauma clinicians who will endeavour to answer your trauma dilemmas, respond to your challenges, and share their collective experiences. A light supper will also be provided giving you an opportunity to network with your colleagues.

Presentations include:

- Rural Trauma Update
- Massive Blood Transfusion
- Update on Head Injury Management
- Airway Management in Trauma
- Case presentations

Day 2: Tuesday 15th November

Trauma Skills: 0900 - 1600hrs (targeted clinician groups, limited places*)

This is an opportunity to refresh those clinical skills often required during the management of major trauma. Small multi-disciplinary (medical, nursing, paramedical) groups will rotate through a number of skill stations lead by experienced trauma clinicians.

5 skill stations including:

- Initial assessment and resuscitation
- Basic airway management
- Rapid sequence induction and surgical airways
- Shock and IV access
- Chest drain insertion



Day 3: Wednesday 16th November

Trauma Team Training: 0800 - 1630hrs (by invitation only, limited places*)

The SCSSC will hold the Australian Trauma Team Training course on site. Using high fidelity manikins, trauma teams will rehearse the management of severe trauma.

Course Content:

- Team and non technical skills
- Resuscitation using a structured approach
- A Team approach to airway management
- Immersive team based trauma scenarios



* Registration:

Registration is **free** for all three components of the TART program. Registration to the trauma evening is open to all clinicians caring for the injured patient. Participation in the trauma skills component is to be discussed with and approved by the local coordinator of the TART program prior to registration, whilst participation in the trauma team training component is by invitation only.
